



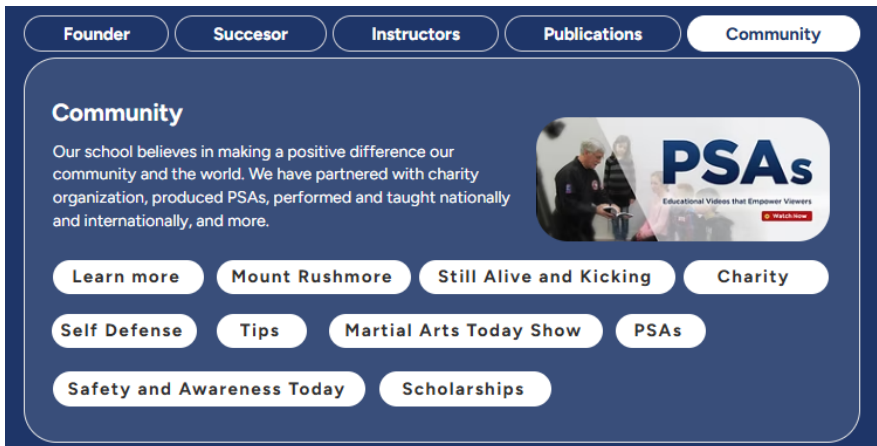
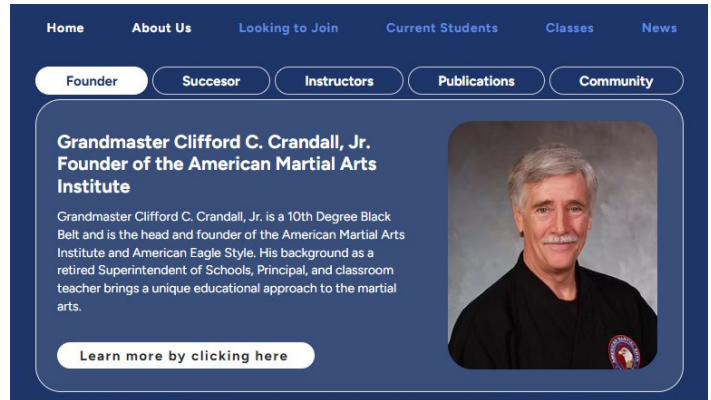

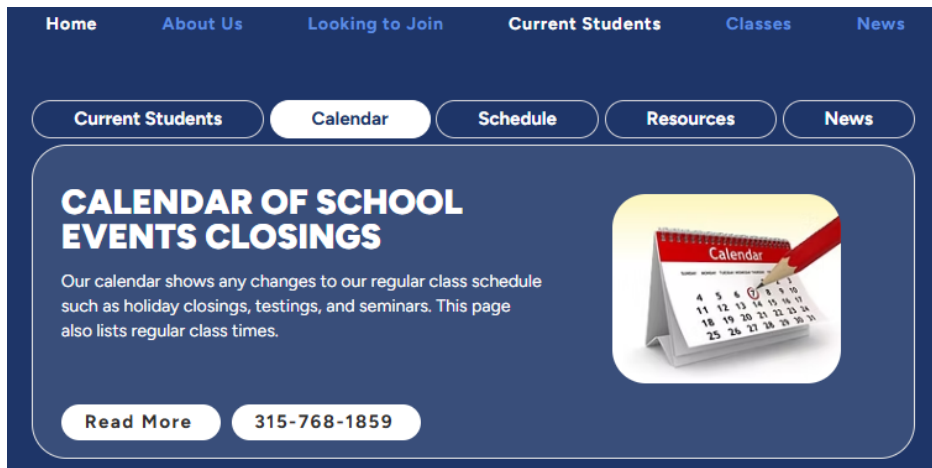

Grand Master Crandall Is Promoted by Master Instructor Tsuneyoshi Matsuno

Grand Master Crandall has become the first American to earn instructor 2nd-dan rank in one of Japan's oldest Samurai sword styles in the world called Takenouchi-Hangan-Ryu-Matsuno. He has received this rank from the head of the style and school, Master Instructor Tsuneyoshi Matsuno, who lives in Kobe, Japan. The certificates are so seldom presented that each is individually written in calligraphy with the International Martial Arts Japanese Association seal on it.

Master Matsuno explained that this was earned based on the combined physical skill and philosophy of thought regarding the Samurai way demonstrated by Grand Master Crandall. In true Iaido the method by which an individual arrives at an answer and the level of answer that individual arrives at are critical to the understanding of the sword and its place in life of that individual.

ABOUT OUR ARCHIVES

The American Martial Arts Institute maintains a library at its main office with records of rank promotions, events, publications, media coverage, photographs, and videos.
